Dear Parents/Guardians,

With the end of the school year approaching, we know your child will be looking forward to the summer break. In an effort to continue student learning, we are asking that you support and encourage your child to participate in our Summer Math and Reading Programs. These programs aim to have students practice math skills and continue reading over the summer. The guidelines for **Math** are as follows:

1. Students select websites from those provided.
2. Students complete math problems and games for 30-40 minutes each week for 6 weeks.
3. Students submit the form on the Meriden Public School's Summer Website to record their time.

The guidelines for the **Reading** program are simple:

1. Students select books of their choice to read.
2. Students record all book information on the online *Governor's Summer Reading Journal*.
3. Students complete ONE book project based on a book of his/her choice.
4. Students submit their summer reading materials online or to their Reading Teacher before **September 1, 2017**.

Students and families may also visit the Meriden Public Library website for other reading activities and support during the summer months. The Meriden Public Library website is meridenlibrary.org.

We ask that you remind your child that math and reading are important and fun, too! **A math and reading celebration will occur in September for students who participate in these programs.**
